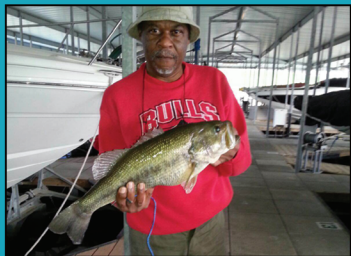

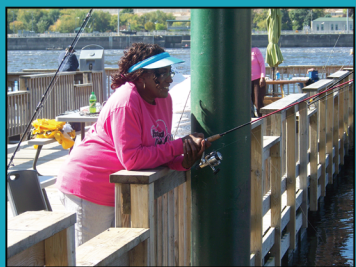

Significant numbers of Large and Smallmouth Bass were caught; however, Crappies were the sought after. At Kentucky Lake in Paris Tennessee, we were at "The World Largest Fish Fry" event and had a wonderful time but came home with an abundance of catfish. While those "paper mouths"/ Crappies, were ever still elusive. From Onalaska, Wisconsin to the pristine shores and waters of Lake Erie, fishing catch creels had been meager at best, but the socialization, fellowship, and education have been off the charts with excitement. One of the bright spots in our fishing travel log, for the club this year has been Devils Lake, North Dakota. We caught so many fishes. It felt as if it was raining walleyes with other table platters like Northern pike and Herculean White bass. As we approach the latter half of our calendar year the prospects for catching fish look even better. A few trips to Minnesota, Southern Illinois (Effingham), Indiana, plus a couple of revisit trips to Winneconne, Wisconsin should keep the freezer full all winter long. So plan accordingly. Blackened Walleye

INGREDIENTS:

- 2lbs of fish (Walleye)
- 1 tablespoon of paprika
- 1 teaspoon of onion powder
- 1/2 teaspoon of cayenne
- 1 teaspoon of salt
- 1/2 teaspoon of black pepper
- 1 teaspoon of garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon ground thyme
- 3 tablespoons of butter

DIRECTIONS:

- Combine all spices on a plate.
- Melt butter in a skillet.
- Coat fish with spices.
- Cook fillets in melted butter, about 3 min on each side.

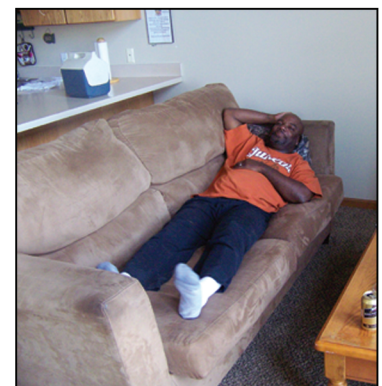

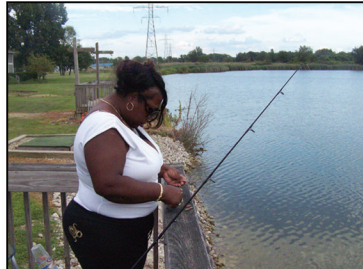
